He is a member of the International Academy of Estate and Trust Law and a Fellow of the American College of Trust and Estate Counsel.

Mr. Tirard has published many articles and books in French and English including « La Fiscalité des Sociétés dans l'UE » (8th edition, 2010) translated in English as « Corporate Taxation in EU Countries » (Longmans) and « Les trusts anglo-saxons et les pays de droit civil » (with Jean-Paul Béraudo, Academy & Finance, 2006). He is the author of the French chapter of "The International Guide to the Taxation of Trusts" published by the International Bureau of Fiscal Documentation.
